Engagement with Regional Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs)


The university collaborates with regional NGOs and development partners to promote community-based solutions, advocate for sustainability policies, and implement inclusive education and capacity-building programs.

Through specialized training programs, workshops, and seminars, AUC empowers students, researchers, and community stakeholders with the skills to interpret and utilize SDG data effectively.




Publication and Knowledge Sharing








Joint Research for Sustainable Solutions
